



2011 Holiday Giving Program Frequently Asked Questions

Q. *Who receives the donated gifts?*

A. More than 1,200 local children and families served by the Sacramento Children's Home's residential treatment and community services programs. They range in age from babies at the Crisis Nurseries to school-age children in residential treatment to young adults transitioning from foster care to independence. For most, the gifts you give will be the only ones they receive this holiday season.

Q. *Should I wrap the gifts?*

A. No. Please do not wrap your gifts. We need to check each item before giving it to a child. You can, however, use a gift bag.

Q. *If I select a Wish Star, what are my options for delivering the gifts?*

A. You can drop off gifts (with the star attached) at:

- The location where you obtained the star
- Any Giving Tree site (listed at www.kidshome.org)
- Distribution Site: Franklin Business Center, 7000 Franklin Blvd., #650, Sacramento, 95823
- Sacramento Children's Home at 2750 Sutterville Road

Q. *Do I have to buy all the gifts listed on the Wish Star?*

A. No. Simply purchase the gifts on the Wish Star that you are comfortable purchasing. Donations of cash and gift certificates allow us to purchase the unfulfilled wish list gifts.

Q. *What if I cannot afford the item the child requested?*

A. That's okay. Every gift is deeply appreciated. Perhaps a gift certificate that can be used to purchase a wish list gift is a good option for you.

Q. *What happens if someone takes a Wish Star and loses it or is unable to purchase the gift?*

A. We will make sure every child's wish list is fulfilled. Donations of cash and gift certificates help us fill in the gaps!
