POSITION: Community Mental Health Worker

SALARY: \$12.72 -\$14.31 per hour

OVERVIEW:

The Community Mental Health Worker (CMHW) is responsible for providing strength and community based rehabilitative services to the clients who have been accepted into the Transition Age Program. The CMHW will work with who have been diagnosed with mental health issues between and are 14 – 21 yrs old. The case load for the CMHW is between 7 – 9 clients. This position is required to work into the evening twice a week for group sessions with a typical group setting of 15 clients. Group sessions may include conducting cooking courses, trips to the grocery store, campus visits to local schools, anger management and/or any another responsibilities that may present themselves.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Work as a part of a team to develop and implement an appropriate individual treatment plan for each client in order to meet their mental health needs.
- Assist clients and families to engage in appropriate problem solving.
- Provide a positive role model/mentor type relationship with clients.
- Teach self-advocacy and independent living skills to clients and their families.
- Utilize community resources to help clients meet the goals of their service plan
- Refer clients to appropriate community resources as needed.
- Help clients to maintain a supportive network within their own community.
- Advocate for clients by working with other agencies and professionals to ensure the client's continuity of care.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Bachelors degree in Social Work, Psychology or other related field and one year experience working in a mental health or similar social services setting is required.

OR

A High School diploma with at least four (4) years of related, full-time experience in mental health may be substituted in lieu of a BA degree.

Must possess a valid California Drivers License, a reliable automobile and auto insurance.
