<u>POSITION:</u>	On-Call Child Care Worker (Infant/Preschool Teacher Qualified)
<u>LOCATION:</u>	North Crisis Nursery
<u>SALARY:</u>	\$9.00- \$10.12 per hour

OVERVIEW:

The Child Care Worker, under the supervision of the Crisis Nursery Supervisor, assists in ensuring the success of the mission of the Sacramento Crisis Nursery; which is to provide a temporary, loving, and safe “homelike” setting for children from birth through age 5 so as to prevent child abuse and neglect by supporting families during times of crisis. This position is responsible for ensuring that the children’s needs are met, performing household tasks (such as cooking and cleaning), and providing developmental and educational opportunities to the children.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Ensures the safety of the children by supervising them at all times.
- Provides direct child care services while being aware of the needs and well being of all children.
- Attends to all child care needs, including but not limited to diaper changes, bathing, feeding, one-on-one interaction, discipline, etc.
- Assists with household tasks including, but not limited to, cleaning, preparing meals and snacks, inventory of supplies/food, laundry, etc. for the children.
- Designs, plans and implements developmentally and age appropriate curriculum for a diverse population of children.
- Prepares and presents preschool and infant activities involving areas such as music, perceptual motor skills, health education, science, creative arts, social studies and language arts.

The nursery operates 24 hours a day and shifts are needed around the clock.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Please Note: All Positions must be able to attend Mandatory Wednesday Meetings from 1pm-3pm and be available for on-call shifts during the week.

- Teachers must have **12 college credits in early childhood education**, 9 of the units must be contain core classes; **programs/curriculum, child and family community, and child and human development.**
- Infant Teachers must have above requirements plus ECE units in an **infant** care or development class.
