<b><u>POSITION:</u></b>	Residential Counselor (Part-Time ONLY)

### **OVERVIEW:**

Under the supervision of the Cottage/Residential Counselor Supervisor and the work guidance and direction of the Lead Residential Counselor, the Residential Counselor is the primary caregiver to the children, providing leadership and supervision. The Residential Counselor ensures the safety and security of the children at all times working in coordination with the cottage team.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Ensures the safety of the residents at all times.
- Assists the children in the performance of regular daily activities, including bed making, personal hygiene, room cleaning, and all other chores normally expected of children their ages.
- Works closely and maintain consistent and appropriate communication with all other staff members as a part of a comprehensive treatment team, including assistance during day rehabilitation groups when necessary.
- Maintains knowledge of each individual child's Target Behavior, Function of Behavior, and Therapeutic Behavioral Interventions.
- Maintains discipline and group control at all times and reports any unresolved conflicts to a supervisor in a timely manner.
- Checks in with the children frequently to prevent crisis situations.

Bachelors Degree in a Behavioral Science is preferred.
