POSITION: Home Visitor (North Sac FRC)

SALARY: \$12.00-13.52/hour DOE

OVERVIEW:

Home Visitor's work with a multidisciplinary team to provide home and community based support services to families identified at risk for child abuse and neglect. They work with a team, under the direction of the Team Leader, to develop and implement an appropriate individual support plan for each program participant in order to meet his/ her needs. Home Visitors also provide home visitation services to 15-20 families in any one week, who have children aged 0-5. The typical working hours are Monday through Friday 8am-5pm, however evenings and weekends may be required from time to time.

Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Conduct in-depth strengths, risks and needs analysis of all members of the family referred to the program.
- Assist families to engage in appropriate problem solving.
- Promote appropriate parenting and disciplinary skills with parents.
- Provide parents with age appropriate developmental activities and expectations for their children.
- Assist adult family members in achieving employment and educational goals.
- Assist family members to better understand their responsibility for the health and well being of themselves and their children.
- Utilize community resources to help families meet the goals on their support plan, referring families to appropriate community resources as needed.
- Provide transportation to appointments, meetings and classes as needed.

QUALIFICATIONS:

BA Degree in social services **highly preferred**. Classes in Child Development and Early Education are **required**.

Three years prior experience working in social services, in-home and community settings with overburdened families is **required**. One year case management experience preferred.

Applicants fluent in Russian or Hmong are **highly desired**.
