**OVERVIEW:**

**These positions are NOT Sacramento Children's Home employee positions.** They are volunteer National Service positions through **AmeriCorps and the Child Abuse Prevention Council (CAPC)**. After successfully completing 12 months of service, **AmeriCorps** members are eligible for an education award of up to \$3,247.50 through the **Corporation for National & Community Service** that may be used for tuition, student loans, books, etc.

The Youth Mentor AmeriCorps Member is responsible for providing a comprehensive program that has been developed for the foster youth students who live in our residential group home. The Youth Mentor AmeriCorps Member guides foster youth life skills activities to build skills necessary for a successful transition to adulthood, including graduation from high school. This position is responsible for tutoring students on an individual and small group basis based on the academic plan. This position comes in contact with confidential information and as such must maintain the program and agency's standard of strict confidentiality.

**DUTIES INCLUDE:**

- Provide mentoring, homework assistance, and life skills support to foster youth at school and/or residential setting
- Complete Casey Life Skills Assessments, collect and submit monthly data
- Conduct life skills workshops and activities related to the Casey Life Skills Domains of Communication, Daily Living, Academics/Study Skills, Home Life, Self-Care, Social Relationships, Housing/Money Management, Career Planning, and Work Life
- Work closely with SCH staff in school advocacy and support for residents
- Attend mandated AmeriCorps trainings

**QUALIFICATION:**

- One year of classroom experience working directly with youth is highly preferred
- A high school diploma or GED is **required**
- **Must** be at least 21 years' old
